**ORDINANCE NO. 2010-02**

**AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING A MORATORIUM ON CERTAIN PROVISIONS  
OF THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE OF THE  
ST. CHARLES COUNTYSIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT  
(RESIDENTIAL AUTOMATIC SPRINKLER SYSTEMS)**

**WHEREAS**, the St. Charles Countryside Fire Protection District (the "District") has heretofore adopted a Fire Prevention Code pursuant to Ordinance No. 2005-04 on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2005 (the "Fire Prevention Code"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Prevention Code has been amended from time to time and is now in full force and effect within the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the District has heretofore enacted a moratorium on the enforcement and application of certain provisions of Article VI of the Fire Protection Code relative to Residential Automatic Sprinkler Systems (the "Moratorium"), which Moratorium expired on December 31, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, the District has determined that it is in the best interests of the District and its residents to extend the Moratorium on the provisions of the Fire Prevention Code applicable to Residential Automatic Sprinkler Systems until further action of the District Board of Trustees, or through and including December 31, 2010, whichever shall first occur, in order to consider, evaluate and adopt the updated versions of the ICC International Fire Prevention Code and other national fire codes as revised in September 2008, and to consider the action of other Districts or Departments in the interest of uniformity;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE ST. CHARLES COUNTRYSIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:**

**Section 1:** The facts, statements and finding set out in the preamble to this

Ordinance are hereby found by the Board of Trustees of the District to be true and correct

and are hereby adopted and incorporated as part of this Ordinance.

**Section 2:** The Moratorium on enforcement and application of the Residential

Automatic Sprinkler Provisions of Article VI of the St. Charles Countryside Fire

Protection District Fire Prevention Code heretofore adopted be and hereby is extended

until further action by the District's Board of Trustees, or to and including December 31,

2010, whichever shall first occur.

**Section 3:** All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions

of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 4:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days after its

passage as provided by law.




